### CONFERENCE OVERVIEW AND TARGET AUDIENCE

This program will review new approaches to common toxicological problems, poisonings of high morbidity and mortality, and changes in the clinical management of the poisoned patient. This educational activity is designed for physicians, mid-level providers, nurses, and pharmacists in particular those working in emergency medicine, internal medicine, pediatrics, critical care, and family medicine. It will particularly interest those preparing to take the certification exam for Certified Specialists in Poison Information (CSPI).

### OBJECTIVES

Following the conference, the participant will be able to:

- Differentiate between various toxic syndromes of poisoning and describe the approach to unknown substances
- Describe the changes in the medical management of poisoned patients
- Assess specific toxic effects resulting in high morbidity and mortality
- Describe the role of the healthcare provider related to health literacy and patient outcomes
- Describe ethical dilemmas in treating poisoned patients
