**PEDIATRIC ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FELLOWSHIP.** Boston Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School are pleased to announce one open-position in our two-year, EPA-sponsored, advanced fellowship training in pediatric environmental health. The program focuses on clinical instruction in children's environmental health, women's reproductive environmental health, and fundamentals of environmental toxicology. To build core competencies in environmental health, the program emphasizes clinical service delivery, teaching, mastering of scientific and grant-writing skills, advanced training in biostatistics and epidemiology, development of advocacy skills, critical review of the environmental health literature, risk assessment, and risk communication. Includes tuition subsidy and eligibility to apply to Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health MPH program in environmental health.

Board eligible or board certified in pediatrics required. Application requires three letters of recommendation, one of which should be from training program director. Site visit for interviews optional but preferred. Completed applications and all letters are due by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2016.
